1. CALL TO ORDER & INTRODUCTIONS

4. OPEN TO PUBLIC

5. ACT 250

Regenerative Land Holdings LLC– Change in use of the former Green Mountain College campus to a destination hotel– Poultney - <u>1R0959-1</u>. Gildrien provided a review of the prospective development at the former Green Mountain College campus for the Regenerative Land Holdings LLC. Pelkey, Poultney, also provided an overview of the project from the Town of Poultney's perspective with some history of the Site. Motion by Spencer to recommend to the full board sending a letter to the NRB stating, conformance with the regional plan and no significant regional impacts. Second by Wilson. Approved by voice vote.

Ottauquechee Realty Advisors, LLC- Three-lot subdivision of the 25-acre parcel permitted for master plan development under LUP 1R0322-15 – Killington - <u>JO 1-461</u>. Reviewed by committee no action taken.

Majaco Killington LL - The subdivision of a +/-28.69-acre parcel of land into eight (8) individual lots (Lots A through H), and the construction of a single-family residence and appurtenant infrastructure on six (6) of those lots – Killington - <u>1R1002-1</u>. Reviewed by committee no action taken.

Rutland Town Elementary– Re-grading portions of the site as well as installing new culverts and catch basins- Rutland Town - <u>JO 1-471</u>. Mount Holly Elementary School – The construction of a 2,000-sf addition to the - Mount Holly Elementary School – Mount Holly - <u>JO 1-470</u>. Castleton Elementary School- Proposed stormwater project at Castleton Elementary School – Castleton - <u>JO 1-467</u>. Rutland City Middle and Intermediate School - Proposed stormwater project at Middle and Intermediate Elementary School – Rutland City - <u>JO 1-466</u>. Poultney Elementary School - project will consist of disconnection to

filter strips at multiple locations on the site as well as the installation of a new drywell – Poultney - <u>JO 1-465</u>. Fair Haven Union High School - Installation of a gravel wetland- Fair Haven - <u>JO 1-464</u>. *All Green School Initiative Projects reviewed by committee no action taken*.
