2:10 NEW PROJECT REVIEW

The Committee reviewed the two new projects: 63 Cherry Street, Rutland, Vermont 05701: Phase 1 ESA for the reconstruction of a multi-unit dwelling for Claire Purcell, a private developer, and 3092 Cold River Road, Rutland Town, Vermont, 05701: Phase 1 ESA for the purchase of a commercial property for Habitat for Humanity ReStore retail establishment. The Committee scored both projects using the new site evaluation form. Motion by Bove to recommend to the full board approving the new Phase 1 projects as 63 Cherry Street and 3092 Cold River Road. Seconded by Black. Approved by voice vote.
