5. SECTION 248

25-2623-AN - 60-day advance submission of Vertex Towers LLC , pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248a(e), proposing to request a certificate of public good authorizing the installation of wireless telecommunications equipment at 100 Seward Hill Road in East Wallingford, Vermont. The 140' lattice tower will hold Verizon wireless equipment and is early in the permitting process. The developers are planning a balloon test sometime in December and are hoping to get as much feedback from the public as possible. The project is intended to bring wireless service to an underserved area in East Wallingford. The Town of Wallingford did review the project, and it received some opposition from adjacent landowners regarding health impacts. The Town of Wallingford is planning to submit comments during the CPG period. Motion by Reed to table any comments until the Certificate of Public Good (CPG) application is submitted. Seconded by Marsh. Approved by voice vote.
