MEETING MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER & INTRODUCTIONS

The committee was called to order at 6:04 PM by Chair Gibbs. Introductions were made.

2. APPROVAL OF FEBRUARY 17TH AGENDA

Motion by Courcelle to approve the February 17th agenda. Seconded by Gibbs. Approved by voice vote.

3. OPEN TO PUBLIC

No public present.

4. TINMOUTH TOWN PLAN REVIEW & CONFIRMATION OF PLANNING PROCESS

The Tinmouth Town Plan, adopted on December 11, 2025, was reviewed by the Community Committee for conformance with state statute and the Rutland Regional Plan. Beatty reviewed the plan using the Municipal Plan Checklist and found that it met state statute. Beatty identified that an implementation matrix would be a beneficial addition but the goals and policies met statute. The Town is planning to amend the plan to include a new Enhanced Energy Plan (EEP) and additional sections such as Scenic Resources. Commissioner Gilmore mentioned that the town plan was developed with the help of the Tinmouth Planning Commission, which have nine members that participate fully. Gilmore thanked the RRPC for their support. Commissioner Courcelle highlighted the great work of the Tinmouth PC and specifically honored the legacy of Bob Lloyd, a longtime town and regional planning commissioner. Motion to recommend to the full board confirmation of planning process and approval of the Tinmouth Town Plan by Gibbs. Seconded by Courcelle. Approved by voice vote.

5. SUDBURY TOWN PLAN REVIEW & CONFIRMATION OF PLANNING PROCESS

The Sudbury Town Plan, adopted on December 15, 2025, was reviewed by the Community Committee for conformance with state statute and the Rutland Regional Plan. Beatty reviewed the plan using the Municipal Plan Checklist and found that it met state statute. Beatty identified a number of clerical and semantic issues, such as the energy chapter lists “enhanced energy plan” but it is not an enhanced energy plan. There are a number of issues with formatting. Weaver mentioned that the plan was a light update, and the town planning commission plans to do a more amendments in the short future. Motion to recommend to the full board confirmation of planning process and approval of the Sudbury Town Plan by Courcelle. Seconded by Reed. Approved by voice vote.
