MEETING MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER & INTRODUCTIONS

The Committee was called to order at 6:05 PM by Chair Berner. Introductions were made.

2. APPROVAL OF MAY 19TH AGENDA

Motion to approve the May 19th agenda by Reed. Seconded by Schneider. Approved by voice vote.

3. APPROVAL OF APRIL 21ST MINUTES

Motion to approve the April 21st minutes by Reed. Seconded by Schneider. Approved by voice vote.

4. OPEN TO PUBLIC

No public comment.

5. SECTION 248

[26-0677-PET](#) - Petition of Vertex – Vermont Towers, LLC and Bell Atlantic Mobile Systems, LLC requesting a certificate of public good, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248a, authorizing the installation of wireless telecommunications equipment at 100 Seward Hill Road in Wallingford, Vermont. Berner/Wallingford shared that the town has no objections against the project so the committee agreed to recommend to the full board a letter of support, citing significant regional impact and conformance with the regional plan based on the fact that the tower will extend cellular coverage to East Wallingford and parts of Mount Holly along Route 103. Francis Parisi from Vertex Towers, LLC was present and provided an overview of the project plans. Motion by Reed to recommend to the full board issuing a letter to the Public Utilities Commission stating significant regional impact and conformance with the Regional Plan. Seconded by Schneider. Approved by voice vote.

[26-0736-PET](#) -Petition of Airport RD1 VT Solar, LLC, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248, requesting a certificate of public good for a 4.975 MW electric generation facility in Fair Haven, Vermont. The Committee reviewed the application and noted impacts to prime agricultural soils, forest blocks, and archeological resources identified by the State of Vermont. The Committee decided



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to table this until further information is available regarding these issues and the Town provides feedback on their position.
